Publication of GP net earnings

for the year period ended 30th June 2014

“All GP practices are required to declare the mean earnings (e.g. average pay) for GPs working to deliver NHS services to patients at each practice.”

The average pay¹ for GPs working in King Edward Street Medical Practice for six months or more in the last financial year was **£49,320** before tax, National Insurance and employee pension contributions.²
This is for 1 full-time GP, 1 part-time GP and 1 locum GP.

¹ In producing the final figures, the total of relevant income for all qualifying practice GPs is added together and divided by the number of GPs to give the average pay.

² All published earnings are pre-tax, National Insurance (NI) and employee pension contributions and for GP partners the figures are net of practice expenses incurred.

- Practice expenses: includes staff costs, general running costs for the practice, and depreciation.
- Personal expenses (business expenses): covers transport costs for home visits, MDU, GMC and BMA subscriptions, mobile telephone costs and business use of capital allowances claimed on motor vehicles.
