for the year period ended 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018

"All GP practices are required to declare the mean earnings (e.g. average pay) for GPs working to deliver NHS services to patients at each practice."

The average pay<sup>1</sup> for GPs working for six months or more in King Edward Street Medical Practice in the last financial year was **£29,171** before tax and National Insurance.<sup>2</sup> This is for 5 part-time GPs and 1 locum GP.
