You can now book evening or weekend appointments with a NHS GP, Nurse or other practitioner

The GPs in Oxford have set up a new service that provides additional appointments in the evenings and weekends. This new 7 Day Access Service makes it easier for patients registered with a GP in the city to receive advice or care at a time that is convenient.

The service will be provided by a team of GPs, Advanced Nurse and Paramedic Practitioners, Clinical Pharmacists and Practice Nurses.

As well as offering medical advice and treatment on everyday health problems and long-term medical conditions, the team will provide nursing care too – such as wound dressing changes, catheter care, blood sampling and cervical smears.

How do I get an appointment and where do I go?

Appointments are booked through your Practice reception. The Receptionist will also be able to advise you on whether or not the 7 Day Access Service is the best option for you or whether an appointment at the Practice would be better suited to meet your needs.
